CAREER STUDIES CERTIFICATE IN COLLISION REPAIR TECHNOLOGY (NON-STRUCTURAL)

Complete in as few as 2 semesters / 16 credits

Fender benders and minor accidents often result in dented and damaged vehicles. Learn to perform non-structural vehicle repairs, including panel replacement and alignment, glass replacement, dent repair, and plastic/composite repair in a specialized repair shop setting.

CAREER STUDIES CERTIFICATE IN COLLISION REPAIR TECHNOLOGY (REFINISHING)

Complete in as few as 2 semesters / 16 credits

Students who complete this certificate are prepared for an entry-level position at a collision repair facility performing refinishing work and paint defect diagnoses. You'll gain the expertise necessary to restore damaged vehicles to showroom ready. Course work covers vehicle preparation, paints and thinners, painting techniques, and paint defect diagnosis.
