STEPS FOR GETTING STARTED

1. APPLY FOR ADMISSION & ACTIVATE YOUR STUDENT ACCOUNT

After you complete the application, you can set up your student account at tcc.my.vccs.edu.

2. APPLY FOR FINANCIAL AID

Planning to use financial aid? Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) form at fafsa.ed.gov. The FAFSA code for TCC is **003712**.

3. DEMONSTRATE COLLEGE READINESS

TCC uses multiple measures, including the Virginia Placement Test, to determine a student's readiness for college-level English and math courses. Learn more at tcc.edu/placement.

4. SCHEDULE YOUR ADVISING APPOINTMENT
