Complete in as few as 2 semesters / 24 credits

Pharmacy technicians order, stock, package, prepare, and dispense medications under the supervision of a licensed pharmacist. You'll also be prepared to take the National Pharmacy Technician Certification Examination to become a Pharmacy Technician (Commonwealth of Virginia Board of Pharmacy).

### **SELECTIVE ADMISSION**

Admission to the pharmacy technician program is very selective and requires a separate application in addition to general admission to the college.

Applications are accepted throughout the year.

Admission to the college does not guarantee admission to the pharmacy technician program.
